A wide range of surgical services are provided for both adults and children within both hospital and office based settings. Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeons have had hospital based anesthesiology training so as to be qualified to administer both local anesthesia and intravenous sedation/ general anesthesia .

The Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery scope of practice includes:

Extraction of teeth and retained roots in the jaws.

Surgical removal of impacted teeth and wisdom teeth (unerupted teeth).

Surgical exposure of unerupted teeth for orthodontic therapy.

Pre prosthetic surgery: preparation of the upper and lower jaw for dentures.

Implants for the replacement of lost teeth or to secure and stabilize dentures.

TMJ/ Facial pain: Non- surgical and surgical management of temporomandibular joint disorders.

Treatment of traumatic injuries to the teeth, jaws and facial skeleton.

Treatment of cysts, tumors and other pathology involving the teeth, jaws and salivary glands.

Management and treatment of oral infections.

Orthognathic and Cosmetic Surgery: surgical repositioning of the jaws.

Surgical procedures utilizing a CO2 laser.
